\$350/week for horses in training program

\$450/week for horses not in training program

- -Includes any training rides and rider coaching
- -Handling of entries

\$50/horse weekly set up fee

<u>\$50 discount</u> for horses in training program showing multiple weeks for the second consecutive week of showing

Schooling show day fee \$75/day

- -starts the day the horse arrives at the show
- -\$30 set up fee

Travel shows

\$50/day trainer Per Diem split among horses attending show

Trainer Hotel/Housing split among horses attending show

Hauling

\$100 round trip minimum for local shows

\$1.50-\$2 mile for non-local shows or paid to professional hauler

Other Charges

Tack/grooms stalls are split among horses and added to show bill

Feed and bedding split among horses and typically added to show bill or invoiced from Brooks Equestrian

Calming pastes and meds such as Ulcergard or Bute/Banamine will be added to invoice if not provided by owner

Groom fees paid directly to groom (typically \$85-\$100/day)

Braiding fees paid directly to braider by Saturday night
